First Aid Control	Accidents & Injuries	All	High	A First Aider MUST be on site at ALL times. First Aid kit MUST be available at ALL times. Proximity of warm building. Accident procedure to be actioned, accident book MUST be completed and emergency procedure followed.	Low
Equipment	Personal Injury	Users Staff	Medium	Adequate briefing of group at start of activity. Instructor to observe group whilst lifting and carrying of equipment. Long and heavy items of equipment to be carried by at least two people. All participants to wear appropriate footwear at ALL times. Helmets to be worn at instructors discretion.	Low
Vegetation, Stings, Scratches or Bites	Personal Injury	Users Staff	Medium	Appropriate footwear MUST be worn by participants and instructors at ALL times. Briefing about careful movement over wet and uneven surfaces. Brief participants about potentially hazardous vegetation and biting insects. First Aid kit to be available at ALL times.	Low
Weather	Hypothermia Sunstroke	All	Medium	Appropriate clothing must be worn at ALL times. Proximity of warm building. In the event of thunder and/or lightning ALL participants MUST evacuate the area. Evacuation procedure is 3 blasts of a fog horn or whistle. No return to activity area until 30 mins. after last thunder and 45 mins. after last lightning.	Low
